#### Form Battalion:

For Drill: 3C/First Call, 3C/Assembly (Fifes: Drill Call), 3C/To the Colors.

For the March: 3C/The General, 3C/Assembly, 3C/To the Colors.

For Issue: 3C/Assembly (one drum on company street)

For Dress Parade: 3C/First Call, 3C/Assembly, 3C/Adjutant's Call, Girl I Left.

#### Dress Parade:

Trooping the Line: 3C, Poor Cato, German QS, British Grenadiers 1, 3C,

Inspection: Sidebeat Round: King William, Prince Edward, British Grenadiers, Hog Eye Man, and Poor Cato (if not already played). The drums play the beat twice, once with fifes tacit and once with fifes. The sequence is always in the order of the B&E book.

Evening: Retreat: 3C/Retreat.

Dismissal: any Marching Tune.

#### Flag Ceremony:

Raising: 3C/To the Colors/Star Spangled Banner, Yankee Doodle, or Columbia

Lowering: 3C/To the Colors/Retreat

Retreat w/o Flag Lowering: 3C/Retreat or Quick Retreat

Bruce and Emmet: Doublings, New Tatterjack, Slow March, Downfall of Paris, Cold Ground, Trust to Luck, Doublings.

Alternate Tattoo: 3C, Doublings, Chester, Doubleings, Minstrel Boy, Doublings,

Duke of York, Doublings, King William, Doublings, Yankee Doodle/Double Doodle, 3C,
